

Repeat examinations in the study programs CTS, DSM, INF and ICS

The following regulations apply to examinations that have to be repeated or made up for in the CTS, DSM, INF and ICS degree programs:

- Repeat examinations usually take place in the examination weeks of the following semester (§13(3) of the study and examination regulations).
- If a course is held in the current semester, the current lecturer is also the examiner for those retaking the exam. This may result in a change of examiner.
- For courses in the compulsory and specialization areas, a repeat examination is normally also offered if the class is not held in the current semester. In this case, the lecturer who last held the course is the examiner for the repeat examination.
- Course achievements (exam prerequisites) that have already been passed are still valid for repeat examinations. However, course achievements can only be completed in the semesters in which the course is held.
