

Application for the scholarship Deutschlandstipendium

Winter semester 2022/23

The Deutschlandstipendium supports students as well as beginning students whose career is expected to provide outstanding academic and professional achievements.

Requirements

You must be enrolled at the THU in order to apply.

The scholarship can be combined with the BAföG¹ benefits and does not depend on your income; however, double funding through other scholarships is not possible.

If you are studying in a degree program that is administered by a partner university, you may apply for a Deutschlandstipendium at the partner university. Students in a paid contractual relationship with a company (e.g., integrated degree programs according to the Ulm model, studies with in-depth practice) are excluded from the Deutschlandstipendium due to their special relationship with the companies.

Scholarship period

The THU grants the Deutschlandstipendium sponsored by the Federal Government for the winter semester. The scholarships are granted for a period of one year and are re-advertised for each winter semester.

Estimated total number and distribution of scholarships

Presumably, a total of 15 scholarships will be granted. According to the Statutes of the THU, the scholarships shall be distributed as follows:

Students in Bachelor degree programs	11
Applicants and students in Master degree programs	2

Application

Please submit your application either in writing to the THU (Technische Hochschule Ulm, Prorektorat Studium und Lehre, Prittwitzstraße 10, 89075 Ulm), or electronically via your own university account (sent as ONE PDF document to prorektorat-lehre@thu.de).

The application has to contain the following documents:

- fully completed and signed "Application for the Deutschlandstipendium" (to be found on the homepage of the THU concerning the Deutschlandstipendium, in the download area)
- motivation letter/application letter (1 page max)
- CV in tabular form
- evidence of any current extra-curricular commitment (e.g., voluntary work, social/university political/political commitment, participation in religious communities/unions/associations, special successes/awards/prizes)
- evidence of special personal or family circumstances (e.g., diseases/disabilities, origin, care of one's own children (especially as single parent), care of a close relative in need of care, or migrant background)

It is hereby expressly indicated that you are obliged to give notice of any changes significant for the granting of the scholarship.

Application deadline

The deadline for applications is **3th of October 2022**.

Applications that are not submitted on time or not in proper form will not be considered in the selection process.
